

Who is Chloe Rombach?

Chloe was raised in Marblehead MA and is a 2010 graduate of Marblehead High School and a 2014 graduate of UMASS Amherst. She was struck by a car on a rainy night in December 2014, when she was only 22 years old. Deprived of oxygen for nearly 20 minutes before firefighters freed her from under the vehicle, she nearly lost her life. She has not regained full consciousness since the accident and currently resides in a hospital about an hour away from her family. Her parents, Jeannie and Ed, and her artist sister, AJ Rombach, have been diligently raising funds, recruiting help and caring for Chloe with daily turns at the hospital ever since that horrible day. They are making modifications and renovations to their house, to make it suitable for Chloe and bring her back home. **100% of all monies earned from these four monthly coaching calls will go directly to the Rombach family.** It is their bank account that receives all payments directly from the Crowdrise website.
